



TUITION FEES

There is no charge for the evaluation of formal or informal credits and experience as students apply for admission to IIOM.

Tuition fees include course syllabi, study guides, and final examinations for each course. Students are responsible for purchasing textbooks, as required for most courses. The tuition fees for the certificate programs already include the cost of 3 course textbooks that are provided to the student by e-mail in a PDF e-textbook format. Tuition fees are subject to change without notice.

Course credits earned in certificate programs can be applied to degree programs.
